Excerpted from *Our Perfecting World* By Maneckji Nusserwanji Dhalla Chapter XVI – The Family, P 137 – Marriage.

Marriage is a religious duty incumbent upon all, but has now come to be regarded as a duty towards one's community. In ancient times it was held more to be the duty towards one's ancestral dead. Great religions enjoined it upon all. The ancient Hindus Iranians, Chinese, and Hebrews considered it as the most indispensable religious duty. The Aryans, Semites, and Chinese believed that an unmarried man, who died without leaving offspring, must suffer in the next world. It became the universal rule for every boy and girl of marriageable age, fit or unfit, healthy or not, to be married. Among some people, religion enjoined marrying of the girls before they reached puberty. This religious practice resulted in India in the custom of child marriage.

As the entire affair was managed by parents, the bride very often saw the bridegroom for the first time on the wedding day. In many places such child marriages were protected by safeguards. The marriage ceremony may be performed, but the bride was sent to the groom's house to live with him when both reached the age of puberty. Where such precautions were not taken, early consummation resulted in death in many cases of the girl-mothers and their children. Social reformers have been strenuously working for the removal of the evil custom for the last fifty years.

In the early years of the social reform movement, it was the enlightened male leaders that advocated reform in the existing conditions. It is a happy sign of the times that with the spread of education the general awakening that has come over women have brought out women leaders who are participating with men in the reform movement and gradually taking over the work of emancipating and uplifting their womankind in their own hands. In the face of the inevitable opposition of the orthodox classes and apathy of others they are winning over public opinion in their endeavor of raising the age of marriage by legislation.

Marriage at the mature age and by selective love is becoming general in the western world, and the reform is making rapid progress among the civilized peoples of the East. In early times parents got their girls married off at an early age without their consent. The growing tendency among young people today is to avoid marital responsibility. Thousands of girls in western countries lead unmarried lives and earn their living by working in shops, stores, and offices. The meagre salaries they earn do not generally satisfy those that are fond of fashionable dresses, and are often attracted by the glamour of night life of large cities. Such conditions create a novel situation in social life which is detrimental to morals.

Cyrus Bharucha is a multi-talented writer, producer, and director who has made significant contributions to the film industry. Cyrus trained as a photographer and joined the BBC film department as a cameraman. He worked on various programs for the BBC, from dramas to documentaries, music, current affairs, and more. He became a producer in the Current Affairs department producing and directing stories around the world, including the floods in Pakistan, Watergate, and the Yom Kippur War to name a few. In 1976 Cyrus came to the USA and joined PBS where he produced and directed over 80 shows, two of which were nominated for an Emmy. He was a founding producer of CNN where he put out the first day's program in 1980.

Cyrus spent several years as the producer and director of *On Wings of Fire.* In his presentation, Cyrus will speak about the trials, tribulations, and triumph of the role of a producer. Cyrus will use his documentary-drama *On Wings of Fire* as an example of the role a Producer plays in the making of a movie. Most people think all a producer does is raise money. Cyrus will explain the role and how young people can get into the business today.
