THE AWARD CRITERIA

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- (i) Family must be a paid member of Zoroastrian Association of Houston for last **4 YEARS**. (Starting from the year 2020)
 - At least one parent should be a Zoroastrian
 - Student should be enrolled or have applied as full time student in a college, university or other institution.
- (ii) Student member should be a paid ZAH member for last **2 YEARS**(Starting from the year 2020)
 - At least one parent should be a Zoroastrian
 - Student should be enrolled or applied as full time student in a college, university or other institution.
- (iii) The student has attended at least TWO THIRDS of the annual ZAH Sunday School classes

As our community grows, so do our applicants and hence a Student member will **NOT** be eligible to apply for an award if they have already received one.

- This will allow us to be transparent and offer a fair playing ground for all applicants.

NOTE 1: JUDGES REQUIRE THAT ALL APPLICATIONS BE SUBMITTED USING THE PDF FORM AND TYPE WRITTEN.

NOTE 2: ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE LEGACY CONGRESS COMMITTEE NO LATER THAN MIDNIGHT OF JANUARAY 15, OF EACH SCHOLARSHIP YEAR.

JUDGING & EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR ALL APPLICATIONS:

congress2000legacy Awards are merit based.

The judging panel will comprise of Zarathushti Academicians selected from North America.

Applicants are evaluated on all of the following criteria

The ZAH Legacy Award will be judged on both "Academic Excellence" AND "Zarathushti Community Service" With Category & Percentage – giving balanced recognition in order to encourage students to focus on BOTH.


