MISSION

To establish and provide global access to a centralized collection of materials in print and electronic form, primarily pertaining to Zarathushti faith, culture, and history.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Meheryar Rivetna, a member of the Library Committee published his book: Zarathushtra: The Man and the Message. The entire proceeds from the sale the books are donated to the ZAH Library. We have collected \$ 1,355 in 2021 and we continue to get monthly donations. Meheryar has started a Book Study Group that meets on the third Sunday of each month via ZOOM. If you would like to join, please call or email Meheryar.
- The ZAH Library and FIRES jointly established the Bapsi Sidhwa Literary Prize to recognize Zoroastrian authors. The Committee spent a considerable amount of time on establishing the criteria for the Prize which was formally announced in January 2022. We are grateful to Teresa Russo, from the University of Toronto, who mentored us through the process. Feroze Bhandara generously donated \$5000 to the establishment of the award. The first award will be given out at the 12th World Zoroastrian Congress in June 2022.
- The ZAH library has undertaken to write a history of the Association from its inception in 1976 to the building of the Center, its subsequent additions, and finally the establishment of the Atash Kadeh. The sub-committee of three dedicated individuals Rustom Engineer, Arnavaz Sethna and Jehangir Shroff plan to publish a booklet.
- FIRES (housed at the ZAH Library) has rebound two manuscripts that were displayed at the event in January.
- The Dhalla papers entrusted to ZAH have been digitized and available to researchers at zah.library.media@gmail.com.

BOOK COLLECTION

Our total online book collection is now 1970 books (from 2012 – present). This includes collections that are at associations at ZAGNY (NY), ZAC-Chi (Chicago), ZAC-LA (Los Angeles) and ZANT (Dallas). We continue to expand awareness of FIRES via a quarterly newsletter on our user-friendly website www.fires-fezana.org and through Book Awareness in the monthly FEZANA Bulletin, and MANASHNI.
